The Spartanburg Youth Theatre encourages boys and girls in the 3rd-12th grades of all ethnicities and backgrounds to audition.

PRINCIPAL ROLES:

Character	Gender	Suggested Age	Description
Mom	Female	12-18	Helpful and encouraging; very few lines; may possibly be recorded as voiceover; will likely double as one of the dragons
Boy	Male	8-12	Starts out bored and apathetic; struggles with his homework; wants to learn all the secrets about dragons and their love of tacos; must have strong pantomime skills; no speaking lines but is onstage the entire show; must have strong presence
Leroy	Any	8-18	Boy's dog; enthusiastic, loves to play and is Boy's best playmate; scared of dragons; must have strong pantomime skills; no speaking lines but is onstage most of the show; must have strong presence
Man in Suit	Male	12-18	The narrator of the show; comes to life from the TV in the living room; knowledgeable on all things dragons; teaches the boy and Leroy important dragon facts; witty and interactive; must have charisma and personality; Also doubles as the Moxy Clean Guy and a Telenovela Character on TV; role may be split between 2-3 actors; this is the only role with speaking lines
Red Dragon	Any	8-18	Sweet; loves flowers; has little wings; must have strong pantomime skills; no speaking lines
Blue Dragon	Any	8-18	Shy, timid dragon; has paws larger than most; must have strong pantomime skills; no speaking lines
White Dragon	Any	8-18	An energetic and speedy dragon; has large, proud horns; must have strong pantomime skills; no speaking lines
Yellow Dragon	Any	8-18	Silly and fond of pranks; has a little tail; likes to play charades; must have strong pantomime skills; no speaking lines

ENSEMBLE:

3-5 additional dragons may be cast in the show as ensemble depending on the director's vision and the talent and skills shown at auditions and callbacks.

SHOW INFO:

You know what dragons really love? Tacos of course! A boy and his dog are watching a TV show about dragons when they unexpectedly get caught up in the "Do's and Don'ts" of what to serve dragons to eat. The #1 New York Times bestselling book comes to life in a big way as the taco party of all taco parties literally brings down the house. This deliciously funny story will have you laughing out loud and wishing you had read the fine print more closely: "Now Made With Spicy Jalapeno Peppers!"

AUDITION DATES & TIME:

Tuesday, January 17, 2023 *or* Wednesday, January 18, 2023, 5:30pm-7:30pm both nights. You should only audition one of the two nights offered. You may come any time between the 5:30-7:30pm range. Auditionees will be seen in the order their audition form is received.

Save time and fill out your audition form ahead of time. An online audition form will be available on Friday, January 13, 2023 on the "Auditions" page of the website: www.spartanburgyouththeatre.com/auditions. If you fill out your form ahead of time, head straight to the check-in table when you arrive and tell them you filled out your form online. It is not mandatory to fill out your form in advance. You may still fill out the form when you arrive.

CALLBACKS:

A callback list will be posted *after 3:00pm* on *Thursday, January 19, 2023* via the auditions page on the SYT website (www.spartanburgyouththeatre.com/auditions).

Callbacks will be *Saturday, January 21, 2023 from 10am-2pm*. *The date of callbacks is subject to change pending actor & creative team availability.*

At callbacks, actors will read scenes from the script.

Look for signs directing you where to enter.

PREPARATION:

- All auditionees are required to prepare a 30 second-1 minute monologue.
- Auditionees should choose a monologue that shows off strong acting choices and that is age-appropriate.
- Memorization of your monologue is *highly encouraged*.
- If you do not have a monologue, one will be provided for you at auditions. Monologues are available ahead of time, one month before auditions, at the Spartanburg Youth Theatre offices in the kiosk at the end of the hallway when you walk down the stairs to our area. You may use one of these monologues, or you may use one of your own choosing.
- **Bring your schedule to fill-in all your potential rehearsal conflicts on the audition form—*conflicts may NOT be added after casting!***

ANTICIPATED REHEARSAL SCHEDULE:

- Rehearsals will occur Feb 27-Apr 12, 2023-- but not every day. Rehearsals will mainly occur Monday- Friday (5:30-7:30pm).
- *The cast WILL rehearse during Spartanburg County District 7 Spring Break, April 3-7, 2023. Conflicts are highly discouraged during this week and could be a deciding factor in casting.*
- *The cast will not rehearse on Easter (April 9, 2023).*
- REQUIRED DATES ASIDE FROM REHEARSALS
 - Set Build: **Saturday, April 1, 2023 from 10am-4pm**
 - *Actor's will be split into shifts, some called 10am-1pm, some called 1-4pm*
 - Load-in: **Friday, April 7, 2023 from 10am-4pm**
 - *Actor's will work the opposite shift from what they worked at set build*
 - If actors are unavailable for Set Build or Load-in, they **MUST** make up the hours missed from these days. Makeup hours will be coordinated on a case-by-case basis.
- ****As of Monday, April 3, 2023, CONFLICTS ARE HIGHLY DISCOURAGED. CONFLICTS DURING THIS TIME FRAME MAY PREVENT AN ACTOR FROM GETTING CAST.****
- The week of Apr 3-7, 2023, rehearsals will last from 5:30pm-**8:30pm**.
- Below is a PRELIMINARY schedule of planned rehearsal days. However, *rehearsals are subject to change!*
- Actor conflicts will be allowed within reason but must be listed on the audition form. Conflicts CANNOT be added after casting. *Conflicts may be a deciding factor in casting.*
