**SYT Debut*

ACCEPTING YOUR ROLE:

- Unless we hear back from you otherwise, we assume that you accept your role. If you are not present at the cast/parent meeting on **Wednesday, December 17, 2025**, and have not communicated with us otherwise, your role will be recast.

PARENT MEETING:

- The **mandatory** cast & parent orientation will be **Wednesday, December 17, 2025 at 5:30pm** at the Chapman Cultural Center (in the center building; look for signs). It is very important that all cast members and a parent/adult representative attend the orientation.

- After the orientation portion is over, we invite all parents to stay to meet the creative team, and take a tour of the facilities, especially if this is your first time doing a show with SYT. Cast members will get costume measurements and do a few housekeeping things after orientation.
- There will not be a formal read-thru or rehearsal at the parent meeting. Once cast members have completed all housekeeping tasks, you will be able to leave. Rehearsals will officially begin Monday, January 5, 2026, 5:30-7:30pm.
- ***If a parent/guardian is unable to attend this meeting, we cannot allow a cast member at rehearsal until a parent signs all paperwork.*** Parents should make all efforts to attend but if you simply cannot, please contact us (www.spartanburgyouththeatre.com/contactus) so we can make sure you have submitted all paperwork before your child can attend a rehearsal.
- An electronic cast packet and show information will be emailed to those who have been cast *and their parents* by early next week, to the parent and actor email addresses listed on the actor's audition form. Please look over this packet thoroughly and submit it *before* the cast & parent meeting on Wednesday, December 17, 2025.
- A conflict calendar will be on the cast website on the "Show Resources" page that is emailed to you. Please be sure to look over this calendar and confirm that we have all your conflicts recorded correctly. You will have one final chance to add conflicts on Wednesday, December 17, 2025. After that date, no more conflicts will be allowed. *Excessive conflicts that are added may result in dismissal from the production. Actors were cast based off the conflicts listed at auditions, so any excessive additional conflicts cannot be accommodated.*
- Scripts and a tentative rehearsal schedule will be provided at the meeting. There is a \$25 cast fee required for each cast member, as well as opportunities to purchase "Break-a-Leg" ads for the playbill (\$20), a photo link of the show (\$20), and a show T-shirt (\$20), so parents should bring a form of payment to the meeting. We can accept cash or check (made payable to "SYT"). A link to purchase these materials online will be emailed to you with your paperwork. Scholarships are available for the cast fee. Fees are due by Friday, January 9, 2026.
